VNA HEALTH CARE LAUNCHES COMPREHENSIVE "GROWING FOR TOMORROW" CAMPAIGN WITH \$1.5 MILLION DONATION FROM DUNHAM FOUNDATION

Campaign will support plans to expand VNA's services in the Chicago suburbs

Aurora, IL - Today, VNA Health Care launched a three-year, comprehensive "Growing for Tomorrow" campaign to support its efforts to expand services in the Chicago suburbs. VNA kicked off the campaign with the announcement that they have received a \$1.5 million donation from the Dunham Foundation, an Aurora-based non-profit organization. The campaign has an ultimate goal of securing \$5 million that will allow VNA to grow its reach and provide high quality, affordable healthcare throughout the Chicago suburbs to 100,000 individuals annually. VNA currently serves 75,000 patients who reside in the Chicago suburbs, more than any other Community Health Center.

"Today is a cause for celebration as we launch our campaign to support our commitment to providing accessible, affordable, and quality healthcare to our patients and the Chicago suburbs at large. We are incredibly grateful to begin this campaign with a transformational gift from the Dunham Foundation that will help us increase our impact in the communities we serve," said Linnea Windel, President and CEO of VNA Health Care. VNA Health Care's comprehensive campaign, which will run through 2025, is aimed at securing support for the expansion and renovation of its locations as well as adding more services for its patients. This includes new locations in Aurora, Joliet, Kane County, and Villa Park, as well as expansion of the Indian Avenue location in

Aurora and the Villa Street location in Elgin, and improvements at the Highland Avenue location in Aurora. The campaign will also support the expansion of services, including a School-Linked Health Center for the West Aurora School District and new services for older adults.
